Queens, September 22nd, 2009 .- In celebration of WaterpodTM last week, and its docking at the Queens Worlds' Fair Marina, invited artist, Hector Canonge, will present his project **LATITUDE**. **S**. The work constitutes of a walk performance scheduled for Friday, September 25, where the artist, wearing an environmental suit, will leave WaterpodTM to be at Flushing Meadows Park inviting people to participate in his Visual Workshop onboard WaterpodTM on Saturday, September 26. Canonge's participation will culminate with an outdoor live projection on the dome of the WaterpodTM the same day starting at 6 pm.

About LATITUD . S:

The **Walk Performance**, represents an extension of Waterpod's mission to reach out communities. As proposed by Canonge, it references awareness about a possible future need to create sustainable environments where communities will cooperate in the production and diversification of resources. Canonge declared that the "idea is to reach out to the land where various communities congregate at the park, and bring them on board the vessel. A Noah's Ark type of calling." The **Visual Workshop** is the interactive collaborative part of the project where visitors, under the artists' guidance, will build, draw, sketch their versions of Utopic worlds, imagined cities, villages of hope, and sustainable environments using eco-friendly materials. The **Media Projections** in the evening are composed of narratives, based on utopias created by Latin American writers, mixed with real time video of people's presence while visiting the WaterpodTM and the Queens World's Fair Marina.
